Day 1 - October 8, 2018

We're off this morning on our adventure to beautiful Door County, Wisconsin. Home to 5 state parks, 12 lighthouses, numerous cherry and apple orchards, 5 wineries and an abundance of beautiful scenery, Door County has become one of most popular tourist destinations in the United States. Late afternoon we arrive in Fish Creek and our home for the next three nights, the Settlement Courtyard Inn. Tonight we will enjoy an authentic Door County Fish Boil dinner at the Old Post Office Restaurant. Have your cameras ready for the drama of the "boil over". Your new potatoes, onions and freshly caught white fish are boiled in a large kettle outdoors. When they are cooked, fuel is thrown on the fire causing the flames to flare high and the water boils over putting out the fire. It is a sight to behold! We return to the hotel after dinner. **(D)**

Day 2 - October 9, 2018

Enjoy a continental breakfast at the inn this morning before meeting up with our local step-on guide. Our first stop will be at Seaquist Orchard and Farm Market. A tour guide will step right onto the coach upon arrival and give a fun and informative 30-minute tour of the orchards. This farm not only produces about 30 varieties of apples but also is home to over 1,000 acres of tart cherries. Time will be given in the Orchard retail store and bakery where you can purchase apples, jams, jellies, butters, sauces, dried fruits, baked goods and more! It's on to Sister Bay Scenic Boat Tours for a 1 3/4 hour insightful tour along the shores of Green Bay towards Peninsula State Park's 145-year old Eagle Bluff Lighthouse. You will also learn about the rich history of the area, see a millionaire's estate on Horseshoe Island, get up close and personal to view Eagle Cave and hear stories of French Explorers and early Indian inhabitants at Nicolet Bay. Lunch today will be at Al Johnson's Swedish Restaurant. Not only is the food fantastic but the goats

grazing on the sod roof make it a delightful stop for all ages. Some shopping time at Founders Square will be given before returning to the hotel to freshen up for dinner. Tonight we will enjoy a delicious dinner buffet at The Log Den. **(CB, L, D)**

Day 3 - October 10, 2018

A continental breakfast is served at the hotel this morning before we begin another day of touring, this time aboard the Door County Trolley. Our guided trolley tour will visit the best of Door County and include Peninsula State Park, Wood Orchard Market, a scenic lunch at the waterfront "Top Deck Restaurant" at Gordon Lodge and a stop at Door County Brewery for some beer tasting. Our last night in Door County has us enjoying a BBQ Rib or Prime Rib dinner at the English Inn followed by an evening of outdoor entertainment at the Peninsula Players, America's oldest professional summer theater. The gardens are beautiful if you want to take a stroll before the show, watch the sunset or have a beer in the garden. Be sure to bring your jacket as the theater is covered but not enclosed. **(CB, L, D)**
