**Day # 1 - April 4, 2018**

Welcome aboard as we travel through Illinois, Indiana and into the state of Ohio. This afternoon we check into our Independence, Ohio hotel and enjoy a welcome reception and dinner this evening. **(D)**

**Day # 2 - April 5, 2018**

Our travels this morning take us to Gettysburg, Pennsylvania for a guided tour of the Battlefield that changed the course of the Civil War. We will also have an opportunity to visit the New Gettysburg Information and Interactive Visitors Center for an in-depth understanding of the significance of this battle. After checking into our hotel we will be dining at the historic Dobbin House Restaurant. **(BD)**

**Day # 3 - April 6, 2018**

This morning we travel into Washington DC and visit Arlington National Cemetery. A special narrated tram tour will take us to the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier for the changing of the guard ceremony, Kennedy Grave Site and various other important areas of the cemetery. We will also visit the US Marine Corps Memorial and the United States Air Force Memorial today. This afternoon we travel to Mt Vernon, Virginia for a visit to George Washington's Estate and Visitor Center. Here there will be an opportunity to tour the house, plantation grounds and a special theater presentation on the first family.

This evening we will visit several of Washington, DC landmarks illuminated at night. We will be staying in the Washington, DC area for the next three nights. **(B)**

**Day # 4 - April 7, 2018**

We will visit the new White House Visitor's Center for an overview of the Presidents home and area. Later, we will tour our nation's National Cathedral where inauguration events, state funerals, dignitaries from around the world visit as well as US citizens. After lunch (on own) at Union Station, we'll visit the WWII, Roosevelt and Martin Luther King Memorials. After dinner in Georgetown, we will visit the John F Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts. The mega facility has an Opera House, Concert Hall and Performing Arts Theater. This evening we have reserved seats for a play at the Terrace Theater. **(BD)**

**Day # 5 - April 8, 2018**

The day will be spent at the Smithsonian Institute. You may visit any museum you wish, no admission to any of the buildings, however there are security check points before entering. Our tour director will have details about each museum and the best way to tour the complexes. You will also have the opportunity to explore Washington, DC on your own including several popular attractions adjacent to the Smithsonian including the Holocaust Museum, National Archives, Washington Monument, The Capital and African American Museum. This evening we have dinner reservations at the popular Café Deluxe Tyson's Corners. **(BD)**

**Day # 6 - April 9, 2018**

We bid farewell to Washington, DC and travel through the scenic Appalachian Mountain Ranges to South Western Pennsylvania and the Flight 93 Memorial. On September 11, 2001, a hijacked plane crashed into the rugged hills of Pennsylvania as passengers on board Flight 93 tried unsuccessfully to take back control of the airliner that had been commandeered by a terrorist. The memorial is a sobering testimony to the bravery of the passengers and significance of the attack on America. We will overnight in Independence, Ohio with a reception and farewell dinner. **(BD)**
