Day #5 - February 15, 2019

This morning we will visit South Padre Islands Farmers Market. We will then visit the South Padre Conventions Centre's Gardens and the Whaling Wall and enjoy lunch at Senor Donkey. Following lunch, it is off to the South Padre Island Birding Center where we will tour their aviary then back to the resort for a little rest and relaxation before dinner. Dinner this evening is at Blackbeard's. (B,L,D)

Day #6 - February 16, 2019

Today is a free day at your leisure. Enjoy the amenities of the hotel, nearby sandy beach or visit the local park and recreation center. For those of you needing additional groceries a supermarket shuttle will be made today. (B)

Day #7 - February 17, 2019

After breakfast we begin our day with a visit to Sea Turtle, Inc. This sea turtle sanctuary rescues, rehabilitates and releases injured sea turtles. Lunch will be at Parrot Eyes Restaurant. After lunch we will have sandcastle lessons with a master sandcastle artiest where we will learn the tools of the trade and build our own works of art. This evening we embark on an Osprey Dinner Cruise. Here we will watch the sun set over the Gulf and enjoy a delicious dinner. **(B,L,D)**

Day #8 - February 18, 2019

We begin our day with a tour of the UT Rio Grande Valley Coastal Studies Lab where students work to better understand the coastal habitats and issues affecting those along the shore (the cost of admission is \$5.00 per person). The tour will be led by a docent who works in the lab and will explain the importance of their work. We will return to the resort for lunch and the rest of the day is as your leisure. **(B)**

Day #9 - February 19, 2019

This morning we cross the Laguna Madres and visit the city of Port Isabel. The first stop on our journey is the Port Isabel Lighthouse. Of the 16 lighthouses originally constructed along the Texas coast, Port Isabel is the only one open to the public. We will enjoy lunch at Pirates Landing where we will savor the views of the Laguna Madre and shores of South Padre. This afternoon we will look at sunken treasure at the Treasure of the Gulf and the Port Isabel Museum Our afternoon ends as we board the Black Dragon Pirate Ship for a show and cruise. Dinner tonight will be at Pier 19 in South Padre. (B,L,D)

Day #10 - February 20, 2019

Today is at your leisure. Enjoy the sunshine, beach and resort amenities. For those needing food and supplies we have arranged a transfer to your local grocery store. (B)

Day #11 - February 21, 2019

We head north today to Corpus Christi. Our first stop is King Ranch. This ranch today covers over 825,000 acres. A guided tour of the property has been arranged and a hosted lunch. Our next stop is at the USS Lexington, it was commissioned in 1943 and served the United States Navy longer and set more records than any other aircraft carrier. Tonight dinner reservations have been made at Brewster Street Icehouse. **(B,L,D)**

Day #12 - February 22, 2019

This morning finds us at the World Birding Center. Birders across the nation know Bentsen as a treasure trove of "Valley Specialties" or tropical birds found nowhere else in the United States. Lunch is on your own. This afternoon we are off to the National Butterfly Center where more than 200 species have been seen. Dinner tonight will be at Saltgrass Steakhouse. (B,D)

Day #13 - February 23, 2019

Our plans today include a tour of the Sabal Palm Sanctuary. It is home to native species of plants and animals that reach the northernmost limit of their Mexican range and do not occur elsewhere in the United States. This sanctuary harbors one of the most beautiful and critical ecosystems of South Texas and Northern Mexico. We will enjoy a guided tour of the facility and property. Lunch in included at The

Vermillion. After lunch we will visit the Stillman House, one of the oldest houses in Brownsville and the Old City Cemetery Center for tours of Brownsville's past. Our last stop before departing Brownsville will be the Palo Alto Battlefield. Here U.S. and Mexican troops clashed on the prairie of Palo Alto. The battle was the first in a two-year long war that changed the map of North America. Dinner will be on your own at a local restaurant. (B,L)

Day #14 - February 24, 2019

Enjoy the beach and the sunshine....it is a day of leisure. (B)

Day #15 - February 25, 2019

Time to pack our bags and begin our journey home. Our overnight accommodations are in the Dallas area. Dinner is planned this evening. **(B,D)**
