Day #1 Sunday, October 13, 2019

After a morning departure we travel via motorcoach through Illinois and Iowa. There will be a lunch stop en route arriving in Branson late this afternoon. We check into the Grand Country Resort and enjoy the Grand Country Buffet. This evening be entertained by a Branson performance. (D)

Day #2 Monday, October 14, 2019

Following an included breakfast buffet at the hotel we attend Down Home Country Morning Show. After lunch on our own in Branson we will attend the #1 Hits of the 60's Show and 50's, too. This show touches over 100 songs from such artists as Elvis Presley, The Beach Boys, The Supremes, Paul Anka, Buddy Holly, Petula Clark, The Beatles...the list goes on and on. Add over 100 costume changes, fun video and a talented cast of seven and you have got the recipe for the show dubbed "The Most Fun You'll Have in Branson". After the show we return to our hotel to freshen up and enjoy dinner at

Florentina's Restaurant. This evening we have planned a murder mystery with a guided tour of the Titanic Museum. (B,D)

Day #3 Tuesday, October 15, 2019

Following another included buffet breakfast at the hotel we depart Branson for Dogwood Canyon where we have a guided tram tour with lunch at the Canyon Pavilion. Call it a "ride on the wild side" if you will. Step aboard their comfortable, open-air trams and explore the beauty of Dogwood Canyon on our two-hour wildlife tram tour. You will wind through the canyon floor, past towering bluffs and waterfalls making a stop at the Glory Hole (a magnificent blue-green pool where some of our largest trout reside). Then cross the Arkansas border where your tram may mingle with herds of American bison, elk, whitetail deer and Texas longhorn. After lunch we depart for Bentonville, Arkansas where we tour the Clinton House Museum. Built in 1931 it was the first home of Bill Clinton and Hillary Rodham while they both taught at the University of Arkansas School of Law and was where they married in 1975. Following dinner at a local restaurant we check into the Hampton Inn. (B,L,D)

Day #4 Wednesday, October 16, 2019

Breakfast is included this morning prior to our local tour of Bentonville which will include a stop at the Walton Five and Dime. This store was the first to have the Walton name which launched the Walmart brand. We end our tour at the Crystal Bridges Art Museum where we enjoy lunch and admission to the museum. The mission of Crystal Bridges Museum is to welcome all to celebrate the American spirit in a setting that united the power of art with the beauty of nature. Enjoy the natural scenery surrounding the museum and the art masterpieces that line the walls. We enjoy dinner at a local restaurant and then return to our hotel to relax. (B,L,D)

Day #5 Thursday, October 17, 2019

Breakfast will be included at the hotel prior to our departure to Tahlequah, Oklahoma. We arrive late this morning with reservations to tour the Cherokee Cultural Center. This center is the premier cultural center for Cherokee tribal history, culture and the arts located in the heart of the Cherokee Nation. We board our motorcoach and enjoy a box lunch en route to Oklahoma City. This afternoon we check in to the Country Inn and Suites and time will be given to freshen up prior to our Date with the Duke, which will include a guided tour of the Cowboy and Western Heritage Museum, a BBQ dinner buffet and a private screening of a John Wayne movie in the museum's theater. Day #6 Friday, October 18, 2019

After an included breakfast we are joined by a local guide who will share the history of Oklahoma City, which will conclude with lunch on your own and free time in the Bricktown neighborhood. This afternoon we visit the Oklahoma City Memorial and Museum, a memorial that honors the victims, survivors, rescuers, and all who were affected by the Oklahoma City bombing in April 19, 1995. This evening, dinner reservations are at Toby Keith's I Love This Bar and Grill in Bricktown. Following dinner, a private river cruise on the Oklahoma River awaits as we journey through downtown Oklahoma City. We return to the hotel later this evening. (B,D)

Day #7 Saturday, October 19, 2019

Breakfast is included at the hotel before we depart for Enid, Oklahoma. In Enid, we tour Simpson's Movie Studio. Come see where westerns are made! Visit Simpson's Old Time Museum and Skeleton Creek Productions Movie Studio and step back into the old west. Listen to honky-tonk piano music and sip an ice-cold sarsaparilla in the 1880's Saloon. We will enjoy a sandwich buffet at the studio. We depart his afternoon for Kansas City where we have reservations at the New Theatre Dinner Restaurant.
