Day #1 Thursday, May 23, 2019

Day #2 Friday, May 24, 2019

After breakfast we board our motorcoach and travel to Washington, DC. We check into the Gaylord National Resort & Convention Center, our home for the next four nights. This evening, experience a Salute the Sunset Military Concert. World-class performances by bands from the nation's Armed Forces at National Harbor will stir your heart and soul. Dinner this evening is on your own. (B)

Day #3 Saturday, May 25, 2019

After an included breakfast we have a full day of touring planned. Visit the National World War II Memorial, Vietnam Memorial, Lincoln Memorial, Korean War Veterans Memorial, Air Force Memorial, Pentagon 9/11 Memorial, and the Marine Corps Memoria (Iwo Jima Statue). Next is a visit to Arlington National Cemetery. This is the final resting place for President John F Kennedy, Jacqueline Kennedy Onassis, Audie Murphy, prizefighter Joe Louis and thousands of soldiers from every major U.S. War. Time will be given to experience the Changing of the Guard at the Tomb of the Unknowns. We return to

the Gaylord to enjoy a Silent Disco and the Laser Light Show. The garden atrium comes to life with a spectacular kaleidoscope of colorful laser lights, dancing water and samples of some of America's favorite tunes. (B)

Day #4 Sunday, May 26, 2019

Enjoy an included full American breakfast at the hotel before visiting the National Museum of the Marine Corps in Quantico, VA. This museum is a lasting tribute to US Marines – past, present and future. This afternoon we join the American Veteran's Center, United States Air Force and the John F Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts as they present the annual National Memorial Day Choral Festival. This annual Choral Festival honors those veterans past and present who have sacrificed so much for the liberties we currently enjoy in our country. Dinner is included this evening. Prior to returning to our hotel we enjoy an illuminated monument driving tour. (B,D)

Day #5 Monday, May 27, 2019 MEMORIAL DAY

Breakfast is included at the hotel. Stops this morning will be at the Martin Luther King Jr National Memorial, Franklin D Roosevelt Memorial, and The Jefferson Memorial. We next visit the Smithsonian National Museum of American History, a vast, venerable museum chronicling American history through a multitude of impressive displays. Enjoy a VIP lunch hosted by the American Veterans Center. Join Generals, troops and other high ranking officials for lunch before the National Memorial Day Parade. Enjoy the parade from private. VIP seats. We depart the parade area for a driving tour of Old Town Alexandria. Here you will see Christ Church, George Washington Masonic National Memorial, Robert E Lee's Boyhood Home and the Torpedo Factory Art Center. This evening dinner is included. (B,L,D)

Day #6 Tuesday, May 28, 2019

Following breakfast, we depart our Nation's Capital and travel through the Cumberland Mountains arriving in Richmond, Indiana for our last overnight stop. Dinner is included this evening. (B,D)
