Day #1 - Monday July 27, 2020

This museum is dedicated to documenting the history of the United States Navy. Lunch is on your own before we visit the Antique Toy & Firehouse Museum. This museum is home to over 60 motorized fire trucks the largest collection of fire trucks in the world. Also, on display are more than 12,000 antique and collectible toys. Time to depart Bay City and return to Frankenmuth where we have the opportunity to make chocolate clusters. Dinner this evening is at Zehnders. (BD)

Day #3 – Wednesday, July 29, 2020

This morning, after breakfast at the hotel, we will partake in a strudel making class. A local guide then joins us as we set our sights on this Little Bavaria of Michigan. The rest of the morning will be spent at Frankenmuth River Place where you have time to shop and enjoy lunch on our own. This afternoon we will tour the Zeilinger Wool Company. The rest of the day you have time to explore the world's largest Christmas store, Bronner's Christmas Wonderland. While at Bronner's we will visit the Silent Night Memorial Chapel which is a replica of a chapel in Salzburg, which marks the site where "Silent Night" was first sung in 1818. Dinner tonight is at the restaurant where we will have their World-Famous Family Style Chicken Dinner. We return to Bronner's this evening to explore their half-mile long Christmas Lane with 100,000 twinkling lights illuminating the path. (BD)

Day #4 - Thursday, July 30, 2020

We depart Frankenmuth after breakfast and continue our Michigan travels stopping in Hickory Corners. Here we will tour the Kellogg Manor former estate of cereal magnate W.K. Kellogg. Restored to its original grandeur the home is rich with history and elegance. Lunch will be included. Following lunch, we visit the Gilmore Car Museum. The Museum houses one of Michigan's largest collections of classic and vintage automobiles. We continue our travels checking into our Marshall, MI hotel.
