Day # 1 – Saturday, July 11, 2020

Day # 2 – Sunday, July 12, 2020

We return to the mainland where our motorcoach awaits to take us to Ground Zero. We have also included admission to the 9/11 Museum. The balance of the evening is on your own.

Day # 5 – Wednesday, July 15, 2020

Today is a free day. Your Tri-State Travel Tour Director will be available to help plan your days activities. This evening we gather for dinner and a Broadway Show. (Show will not be determined until 30 days prior to your departure). (D)

Day #6 – Thursday, July 16, 2020

We prepare to depart New York City today and travel north along the Hudson River for a tour of West Point Military Academy. Following this very interesting experience, we continue west through New York state, with the Finger Lakes Region on the horizon.
