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Day #1 – Tuesday, June 9, 2020 We begin our exciting journey this morning. This hotel, in its third renovation since its initial opening in 1835, displays the classical elegance of this river town. This evening we stop by the Derby Dinner Playhouse for a dinner show. We return to the Galt House this evening. **(Dinner Show)**

Day #2 – Wednesday, June 10, 2020 We will begin our morning by heading to the Twin Spires at Churchill Downs for a Backstretch Breakfast Tour of the world's most famous racetrack. The morning will consist of breakfast, a walking tour of Churchill Downs, a stable tour, and admission to the museum. We have included lunch at the Derby Café and time watching horses' race on the track. This afternoon, we travel to Claremont for a distillery tour at the Jim Beam American Stillhouse. This evening we have a unique dining experience on board the Louisville Belle. Ride the river and watch Kentucky pass by as you enjoy a remarkable dinner. We return to the Galt House this evening. **(Breakfast Tour, L, Dinner Cruise)**

Day #3 – Thursday, June 11, 2020 After breakfast, we depart for a tour of the Louisville Slugger Museum & Factory, we've heard it many times from guests: "You don't have to be a big baseball fan to love Louisville Slugger Museum & Factory." The factory tour is fascinating. The interactive exhibits are fun. Baseball is such a big part of American history and culture that even folks who don't think they're fans find a connection here. We enjoy lunch on our own en route to Memphis. We check in to the Guest House at Graceland, where we spend the next three nights. This new hotel offers southern hospitality near the home of the King of Rock and Roll. Dinner will be included this evening; the rest of the evening is yours to enjoy the property and relax. **(BD)**



Day #4 – Friday, June 12, 2020 We're off again after breakfast on another fun-filled day. We begin the day with a visit to Graceland, where we will be given a tour of Elvis Presley's home. You can enjoy lunch on your own at any of the restaurants on the premises while you visit the exhibits at Graceland following the tour, you will be provided with a lunch voucher that can be used at dining facilities on the premises. We will then be joined by a musician who will join us on the bus and lead us on a Backbeat Memphis Tour of the city. This tour will include a tour of Sun

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Studios. After we say goodbye to our musician, we will enjoy the evening with dinner and a musical performance at



Blue City Cafe. We will spend the night at our Memphis hotel.

Day #5 – Saturday, June 13, 2020

Following breakfast, we will begin our day touring at St. Jude's Children's Hospital. After our visit to St. Jude's, we have a chance to look back in time to some of the most historic cars at the Edge Motor Museum. After the Motor Museum, we

travel a very short distance to Beale Street for lunch on our own and the afternoon is free to explore this historic area, make sure you check out Jerry Lewis's, Dyers, and many more staples of Memphis. This evening we depart for a Memphis Dinner Cruise. View the skyline of Memphis from the vantage point of the Mississippi River and enjoy a delicious dinner. Day #6 – Sunday, June 14, 2020 We depart Memphis after breakfast and stop at Lambert's for lunch, home of the throwed rolls. We make our way to St. Louis this afternoon and tour Budweiser Brewery.
