Spice houses over 80 individual shops in a 30,000 square foot area making this a "mega" shopping atmosphere. You'll recognize many from Joanna Gaines' televised shopping adventures that has everything you need to add a little or a lot of zest to your life! Collegiate, kids, baby, home decor, men's accessories, jewelry, souvenirs, bath & body, candles, clothing and so much more. For those people not interested in browsing the shops, we will offer a free shuttle to the Texas Rangers Museum and the admission fee. Next, we check into our hotel to freshen up before visiting the Waco Winery Tasting Room and Rooftop Patio. Perched in downtown Waco, enjoy breathtaking views of this central Texas city while sipping your favorite glass of wine. We return to the hotel this evening. (BD)



Day # 4 Waco, TX
Thursday April 16, 2020
Following breakfast at the hotel, we take a motorcoach tour of Waco led by a local guide who will showcase some of the properties and locations that were featured on HGTV's Fixer Upper. We will

also stop by (subject to availability) the Harp Design Company wood working and JDH Iron Design Center where we might just meet Jimmy Don's at the shop! We arrive at the Magnolia Market and Silos, also made famous by the hit HGTV show *Fixer Upper*. Take your time shopping in the Market, checking out the garden, taking plenty of photos (roaming staff members will assist you) and enjoy lunch (on your own) at the food trucks located at the Silos. Delectable cupcakes and other baked goods are available at Joann's Silos Baking Co. For the more

adventurous there is also a free trolley shuttle to several area attractions. Dinner this evening will be at Vitek's which has also been featured on the show. You will have the rest of the evening to explore downtown Waco. (BD)

### Day # 5 Oklahoma City, OK Friday April 17, 2020

This morning we enjoy breakfast at the nationally televised Magnolia Table. Following breakfast, we travel to Oklahoma City and visit the Oklahoma National Memorial. The Memorial is comprised of two separate components; the 3.3-acre Outdoor Symbolic Memorial includes the Gates of Time, which mark the time before and after the bombing took place, and the Field of Empty Chairs, which memorializes each of those killed. Inside the 50,000-square-foot Memorial Museum, interactive exhibits offer a chronological, self-guided experience through the story of April 19, 1995, and the days, weeks and years that followed. Next, we check into our hotel, located in the historic "Bricktown" district of Oklahoma City. Bricktown, is a lively entertainment district, with repurposed warehouse spaces that are home to restaurants, piano lounges and chic wine bars. The eclectic mix of shops offers clothing, home decor and specialty food items like gourmet condiments and handmade chocolates. We enjoy a narrated "Cruise on the River Walk" with the balance of the evening free to explore the lively entertainment and dine at one of the multitude of bistros and restaurants in Brick Town. #### Day # 6 Overland Park, KS Saturday April 18, 2020

This morning we visit the Land Rush Memorial marking the opening of the 1888 Oklahoma Territory to settlers. Dozens of giant, bronze sculptures depicting horses, wagons, soldiers, and cowboys in a race to settle the former Indian Territory are displayed on this expansive setting. Later this morning we visit the Wyldewood Cellars for wine tasting of their unique blends of American grapes. We continue our travels to Kansas City and check into our hotel for the evening. This evening enjoys dining and entertainment at the nationally recognized New Theater presenting "The Million Dollar Quartet". (BD)

### Day # 7 Home Sunday April 19, 2020

This morning we visit "SubTropolis", one of many expansive underground sandstone caverns in the greater Kansas City area that have been converted into storage for a variety of products. The
