Lunch is included at the Overlook Restaurant with its stunning views of the Ohio River. Corydon's downtown historic district is next on our schedule. Shop for antiques, crafts and collectibles, take a walking tour, or visit the old-fashioned soda fountain. Prior to checking into our hotel, we will stop at Turtle Run Winery for a tour and tasting. Day #3 – October 13, 2020

After breakfast included on your list of things to do today is the Zimmerman Art Glass Factory. This is a family business with 5 generations of glass blowers who make handmade glass products ranging from paper weights to lamps and much more. Lunch time finds us visiting Joe Huber's Family Farm and Restaurant. In addition to their family style lunch we have included a wagon tour. One last stop this afternoon before we check into our hotel, Huber's Orchard Winery & Vineyards/Starlight Distillery. This is Indiana's largest wine-grape producer and will produce nearly 400,000 pounds of grapes per year under normal weather conditions. Sample and enjoy during your visit. We check into our hotel and freshen up as we have reserved seats for "Clue-The Musical 2020" at the Derby Dinner Theatre. (BLDT)
