Day # 1 Friday, September 24, 2021

Begin this awesome journey by traveling via deluxe motorcoach across the Midwest and into Ohio for your overnight accommodations. Sit back, enjoy the ride, and meet your new traveling companions. Dinner is included and the rest of your evening is at leisure. (D)

Day # 2 Saturday, September 25, 2021

After breakfast at the hotel, you continue your travels toward New England, crossing a portion of Pennsylvania and New York, stopping this evening in Albany, the capital of New York, for an overnight stay. After checking into your hotel, you are invited to dinner at one of the local restaurants. (B,D)

Day # 3 Sunday, September 26, 2021

Breakfast is served at the hotel before you re-board the motorcoach and travel into Massachusetts. Stop in Deerfield to visit the Yankee Candle Company and Bavarian Christmas Village. We continue into Vermont where you visit the Hidden Spring Maple Farm. This family has a proud history of making high quality syrup for over fifty years. We continue into New Hampshire for our two-night stay. Dinner is included. (B,D)

Day # 4 Monday, September 27, 2021

Breakfast is served at the Inn before a full day of touring in New Hampshire, including two train rides. Start with a guided tour of the White Mountains region, stopping at the Franconia Notch Visitors Center before making your way to Mount Washington. Here you will have lunch on your own and do some shopping before climbing aboard the Mount Washington Cog Railway for a ride to the highest peak in the northeast United States. For your second train ride of the day, you travel to North Woodstock, New Hampshire. Once on board the Café Lafayette Dinner Train, you can enjoy a scenic train ride and a five-course meal with constantly changing views outside your window. (B,D)

Day # 5 Tuesday, September 28, 2021

After another included breakfast, you travel into Maine where your local guide joins us for a Guided Tour of Portland that will include Kennebunkport. Learn about this popular summer resort town, drive by the Bush's summer home and Sea Captain's Mansions. While in Portland time will be given to enjoy the city's waterfront. During your "Maine" day you will also enjoy the Lighthouse Lovers Cruise. This narrated 90-minute scenic cruise takes us through the busy harbor to see lighthouses, forts, lobster boats, seals, and seabirds. Four lighthouses can be seen up close with as many as seven in view during the cruise with a close-up view of Maine's oldest and most photographed lighthouse, Portland Head Light. Overnight will be in Portland with a complete down east Lobster Bake Dinner included. (B,D)

Day # 6 Wednesday, September 29, 2021

A hearty continental breakfast is provided this morning in anticipation of the journey south to Boston. Enjoy a Guided Tour of this historic city that will include historic sites from the Colonial & Revolutionary era, walk to the Old North Church, sites along the Freedom Trail, Boston Commons, Old State House, Boston Massacre Site, Bunker Hill Monument & U.S.S. Constitution. Boston Neighborhoods: Victorian houses, cobblestone streets, Little Italy, and Fenway Park! All this will be preceded by lunch on your own and shopping time at Quincy Market and historic Faneuil Hall. Later this afternoon, you depart for Cape Cod and a two-night stay in Plymouth, MA. Dinner is included. (B,D)

Day # 7 Thursday, September 30, 2021

This has been set aside as a full day to explore some of the wonders of Cape Cod. Our local guide joins us to begin our Plymouth Tour "America's Hometown". Learn about the Pilgrim landing in 1620 and view historic sites including a photo stop at Plymouth Rock. **Mayflower II – Celebrate the 400th Birthday!!** A full-scale reproduction of the Pilgrim's Ship. Learn about the voyage, perils of maritime travel and explore the cramped living quarters. Next it is time to tour Hyannis, see the Kennedy Family compound, JFK Memorial and Saint Francis Xavier Church. Time for you to visit the JFK Museum. Here you will take a glimpse at the life JFK enjoyed in Cape Cod featuring a video taken by Walter Cronkite and photos of time spent relaxing with family in Hyannis. Free time for lunch on your own. We

continue our scenic touring along route 6A “Old Kings Highway”. Learn about the local cranberry industry, kettle ponds, cape architecture and more. Dinner is included this evening. (B,D)

Day # 8 Friday, October 1, 2021

There is breakfast to enjoy before you begin to travel west toward home. As you leave the New England area, travel through a portion of Rhode Island and on into Pennsylvania for your overnight accommodations and an included dinner. (B,D)

Day # 9 Saturday, October 2, 2021
