Day #1 Sunday, June 6, 2021

This is the perfect time to get away and escape to the North Woods for a fun and relaxing start of summer vacation! Duluth, Minnesota is located on the southern shores of Lake Superior, the largest freshwater lake in the world. Upon arrival in Duluth, we will visit the Great Lakes Aquarium. Live animal displays, hands-on exhibits and a knowledgeable marine biologist's staff makes this visit a great experience.

Duluth will be our home for the next two nights at the historic Harbor Front Hawthorne Suites Hotel. We enjoy a Welcome Dinner this evening. (D)

Day #2 Monday, June 7, 2021

A continental breakfast is included this morning and then we depart for an exciting day of scenic touring. We begin with a Duluth riding tour along Skyline Drive where there will be some incredible views of the city as well as Lake Superior. Next, we board the North Shore Railroad for an incredible ride along the north shores to Two Harbors. A special lunch is included before we travel the short distance along the

Lake Superior North Shores to the Split Rock Lighthouse. One of Minnesota's best-known landmarks, this restored site offers a glimpse into lighthouse life from 1910-1969 in this remote and spectacular setting. On our return to Duluth, we make a short stop at Gooseberry Falls State Park to view the unique cascading waterfalls. This evening we board the Vista Fleet for a dinner cruise to enjoy the harbor lights and city of Duluth skyline. (CB, L, DC)

Day #3 Tuesday, June 8, 2021

Following an included breakfast, we bid farewell to the city of Duluth and travel around Lake Superior to our next Lake Superior City, Bayfield. Enjoy the scenery aboard our luxury motorcoach this morning as your Tri-State Travel Tour Director shares history and tales of the area and beautiful Lake Superior. We visit the Apostle Island National Lakeshore Center. After enjoying the many exhibits and learning why they are called the Apostle Islands we are ready for an incredibly special lunch at the Old Rittenhouse Inn. This afternoon we will climb aboard a catamaran vessel to visit sea caves and lighthouses. Prior to checking into our Ashland, WI hotel we have arranged a tour of the local murals. Day #4 Wednesday, June 9, 2021

A continental breakfast is included this morning and then we are ready for another day in the North Woods. Our first stop will be the Wildlife Center and Preserve for an in-depth view of the unique wildlife of the area. Lunch will be at your leisure in Rhinelander. This afternoon we visit the Rhinelander Logging Museum. After checking into our local hotel for our overnight accommodations, we make our way into Minocqua for dinner on your own, (CB)

Day #5 Thursday, June 10, 2021

Today we visit Glacial Lake Cranberries, Inc., producing cranberries since 1873. A local docent will join us to tour the bogs and enlighten us on all phases of cranberry production.
