Day 1 - Shipshewana, IN - Neil Diamond Tribute Show — Travel today takes you to Shipshewana, IN for a night at the Blue Gate Garden Inn. Day 3 - Troyer's Sweet Shop - Victorian Mansion w/lunch - Hershberger's Farm and Bakery - Lamp & Light Candle & Coblentz Leather Shop - Amish Wedding Feast — This morning meet your local guide at the hotel and begin a Back-Country Roads tour. Your first stop at Troyer's Sweet Shop. Here you will make and take with you your very own buckeye candies.

Next you will visit the historic Millersburg Victorian mansion built around the turn of the 20th century and featured on HGTV's Victorian America. Enjoy a tour of the mansion filled with history and possibly ghosts! The home is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Enjoy a light lunch at the Castle Club next to the Mansion.

The afternoon features a stop at Hershberger's Farm & Bakery is a one-of-a-kind destination in Ohio's Amish Country featuring an Amish bakery, store, produce market, food trailer, and a farm animal petting area. Each season offers a different unique experience with different featured products. Summer starts the produce season & you will find a large selection of locally grown fruits and vegetables.

Stop at Lamp & Light Candle Shop for a candle carving demonstration by the Amish ladies. Next, visit Coblentz Leather Shop. Then enjoy a tour of Homestead Furniture which is created with the highest of quality standards — in every step of production. You will learn how the furniture is created first-hand. Everything produced is American-made, because most of the furniture is made within a 30-mile radius of the facility.

Travel this afternoon takes you Middlebury, IN for an overnight stay at Essenhaus Inn. Tonight, enjoy a buffet dinner at the Das Dutchman Essenhaus restaurant. **(B,D)**
