# Pioneer Woman & Magnolia Market

7 Days October 10-16, 2022

**Day 1 – Independence, MO** - Travel today to Independence, MO and the Drury Inn for the night. Dinner is on your own this evening, but you can take advantage of the hotel's 5:30 Kickback Happy Hour featuring a rotating menu of hot foods and cold beverages.

**Day 2 – Pawhuska, OK - Pioneer Woman Mercantile & Dinner – Tulsa, OK** - Today, travel to Pawhuska, OK where you visit the Pioneer Woman Mercantile, owned by Food Network TV show host Ree Drummond, aka The Pioneer Woman, this shop is a must-see destination. The Pioneer Woman Mercantile began in 1910 as Osage Mercantile and was a place for trading goods and browsing.

Ree and family wanted to honor The Merc's legacy by creating a shopping experience that hints to an earlier time in small town America. It takes time to see it all, so stop in and stay awhile!

Come explore the glorious cabinets, browse the abundant shelves, and peek in all the drawers! Shopping at The Merc is a treasure hunt, with surprises everywhere you turn. There is also a Deli and a Bakery where you can enjoy comfort food classics in the deli, to hand-crafted bakery items, the offerings are endlessly delicious.

Before leaving, enjoy dinner that consists of a 4-course meal, appetizers, salads, entrees, dessert and beverage - all made in The Mercantile and served family style. Then you continue to Tulsa, OK for an overnight stay at a local hotel. **(B,D)**

**Day 3 - Tour & Lunch at Southfork Ranch – Waco, TX** - Departing Tulsa, stop Plano, TX to tour the famous Southfork Ranch, known worldwide as America's most famous Ranch. Before the tour, enjoy a great Texas lunch at the Ranch. Continue travel to Waco, TX and check into your area hotel for a two-night stay Holiday Inn Express or similar. Enjoy an elegant and unique dining experience at 1424 Bistro in Waco. **(B,L,D)**

**Day 4 - Magnolia Market & the Silos - Dr. Pepper Museum – Guided Waco Tour** - Enjoy your free time at Magnolia Market and the Silos with time for shopping in the Market, games on the lawn, and touring the garden. And have lunch on your own at the 'Siloteria' – a collection of food trucks located here.

The afternoon features a tour of the Dr. Pepper Museum where you learn the history & see the memorabilia of soft drinks in a 1906 bottling plant. Then meet your Step-On guide for a narrated History & Highlights Tour of Waco. Did you know: The remains of Mammoths (from pre-historic time) were discovered here in 1978; and cattle drives moving herds on the Chisholm Trail crossed the Brazos River in Waco on the historic Suspension Bridge. Just some of the things you may learn about on this tour.

Enjoy some of the best food in Waco - Cajun & Creole - at Buzzard Billy's Restaurant. **(B,D)**

**Day 5 – Oklahoma City, OK - Oklahoma City National Memorial & Museum - Bricktown Water Taxi - Dinner at Toby Keith's "I Love This Bar"** – Travel today to Oklahoma City, OK where on arrival you visit the Oklahoma City National Memorial, dedicated to the victims of the bombing in Oklahoma City of the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building.

The Outdoor Symbolic Memorial stands on the now-sacred ground where the events of April 19, 1995, unfolded. What was once the footprint of the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building, Fifth Street, the Athenian Building and Oklahoma Water Resources Board are now the Field of Empty Chairs, Reflecting Pool and Rescuers' Orchard.

Then check-in at the Holiday Inn Express Oklahoma City Bricktown for an overnight stay. Oklahoma City's most modern, but comfortable, hotel is nestled in the Historic Bricktown Entertainment District while still offering convenience to Downtown Oklahoma City.

Once everyone has freshened up you take a fun ride through the Bricktown Entertainment District with Bricktown Water Taxi. During the water taxi rides, you will learn history about the Oklahoma City buildings you pass, as well as fun facts along the one-mile canal. Dinner is included this evening at Toby Keith's "I Love This Bar" Restaurant.

Named for the country singer's hit single, Toby Keith's I Love This Bar & Grill offers a down-home dining and entertainment experience right in the middle of OKC's historic Bricktown. Come as you are for daily beer specials and good, old-fashioned country favorites like chicken fried steak, pork chops topped with homemade jalapeño peach jam – even calf fries! **(B,D)**

**Day 6 – Kansas City, MO – New Theatre Dinner Show** – Today, travel to Kansas City, MO where you check into the Drury Inn Kansas City, Overland Park for the night. This evening your group will attend a dinner show at The New Theatre (show title to be announced). **(B,D)**

**Day 7 - Depart for Home** - After breakfast, depart for home. **(B)**
