The Best of Niagara Falls USA

6 Days August 7-12, 2023

Day 1 – Perrysburg, OH - After a long travel day, arrive in Perrysburg, OH for an overnight stay at the Holiday Inn & Suites. Dinner is on your own this evening. There are many restaurant options close to the hotel.

Day 2 – Rock & Roll Hall of Fame – Niagara Falls, NY – Seneca Niagara Casino – Depart after breakfast first stopping in Cleveland, OH to visit the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame. See the archives and learn the history of the best-known and most influential artists, producers, engineers, other notable figures who have had some major influence on the development of rock and roll.

Arrive this afternoon in Niagara Falls, NY for a three-night stay at the Seneca Niagara. The Tower's Observation deck extends out over the Niagara Gorge and is the only place in the Park to view both the American and Horseshoe Falls at the same time! Ride the elevator down to board the Maid of the Mist.

Enjoy the NEW Maid of the Mist, one of the most famous boat rides in the world, will take you up close to the Falls where you will feel the spray and hear the thunder. For more than 150 years the Maid of the Mist has taken countless visitors through the foam and spray at the bottom of Niagara Falls. Get ready for damp, but thrilling ride, on their brand new electric pontoon boats!

Next, it's time for a thrilling walk on Niagara Falls' wild side. The spectacular Cave of the Winds Tour takes visitors into a stormy mist zone, where "soaking up the experience" takes on new meaning! The journey begins with an elevator ride 175 feet down into the Niagara Gorge. Geared-up in a souvenir rain poncho and specially designed sandals, guests follow wooden walkways along Niagara River to the Hurricane Deck, just a few breathtaking feet from the torrents of Niagara Falls. Here, rushing Bridal Veil Falls creates tropical storm-like conditions. Talk about a rush! Nowhere else on Earth gets you closer to the Falls!

This afternoon you are free to explore and have lunch on your own in the area. After a break to explore a bit and have for lunch on your own, the afternoon features a winery tour and tasting at an area winery. Niagara Falls USA is home to a burgeoning wine region in a truly unique atmosphere. The cool climate and rolling hills and valleys make for a one-of-a-kind terroir, home to small and large producers alike — and all kinds of grapes. It is now home to over 22 wineries, breweries and cideries.

Dinner this evening is included at Top of the Falls Restaurant. As the only restaurant overlooking Niagara Falls, Top of the Falls Restaurant offers a one-of-a-kind dining experience. The Top of the Falls menu offers modern American cuisine and classic dishes, and every dish is accompanied by spectacular waterfall views. The venue, located within Niagara Falls State Park, on Goat Island, overlooks Terrapin Point, and features panoramic views of Horseshoe Falls through floor-to-ceiling windows and outdoor dining decks. Return to Seneca Niagara Resort & Casino for the evening. **(B,D)**

Day 4 – Rochester, NY - George Eastman Museum – Rochester Public Market – Strong Museum of Play - This morning, head to Rochester, NY for the day. Start with a visit to the George Eastman Museum. This museum provides a glimpse into the life of one of the greatest American innovators and entertainers.

Next, visit the Rochester Public Market with local produce, and locally made and harvested products, specialty items and general merchandise. Indoor and outdoor vendor spots equals to over 300 places to shop! Along with multiple eateries and independent shops in the Market area. Shop a little or a lot and have lunch on your own.

After some good eats and shopping, you'll visit the Strong Museum of Play. Rediscover old memories and discover new ones as you explore a world of play. An ultimate play destination for all ages with over 100,000 square foot of dynamic, interactive space, the museum provides entertaining, educational and unforgettable intergenerational fun! Your admission also includes the Butterfly Garden. Then enjoy dinner at a local restaurant before returning to the Seneca Niagara Resort for the evening. **(B,D)**

Day 5 - Middlebury, IN – Dinner at Das Dutchman Essenhaus – Blue Gate Theatre Show – Travel today takes you to Middlebury, IN for a night at the Essenhaus Inn. Tonight, enjoy a wonderful dinner at Das Dutchman Essenhaus before going to the show at Blue Gate Theatre. Over 300 shows, 100 artists and outstanding Amish Musicals, the Blue Gate is the best place for entertainment in Shipshewana. (Show to be announced) **(B,D)**

Day 6 - Studebaker Museum – Depart for Home – After breakfast at the hotel, stop in South Bend, IN to visit the The Studebaker National Museum. This museum is home to a priceless collection of vehicles, artwork, archival material and artifacts spanning nearly 200 years. The Museum displays the first and last vehicles the corporation ever made and boasts the largest Presidential Carriage Collection in the world. Following your visit, depart for home. **(B)**
