## Day 3 Monday - October 16, 2023 - Cranberry Bog, Plymouth Plantation, Mayflower II & Rock

This morning we visit Stone Bridge Farm for a tour of a cranberry bog. We actually put on a pair of waders to walk out into a flooded field with cranberries floating around us to learn about the techniques of raising cranberries! Next, we'll tour the Plimoth Patuxet Museum. This plantation is as it was in the 17th century: with a centuries-old Wampanoag home site, village buildings of the time period, costumed docents, the fragrance bluefish roasting slowly over a bed of hot coals the sharp smell of gunpowder during a military drill, and the sound of laughter around a glowing hearth. After exploring the village and grounds, we have an included theme lunch at Plimoth Plantation. Come aboard the Mayflower II for an extraordinary experience. The details of the ship from the solid oak timbers and tarred hemp rigging to the wood and horn lanterns and hand-colored maps, have all been carefully recreated to give you a sense of what the original 17th-century boat would have been. We'll also learn about the 1620 voyage of the Mayflower, the perils of maritime travel, and the tools of 17th-century navigation. It is but a short walk to Plymouth Rock where the Pilgrims first set foot in the New World in their quest for religious freedom. Later, we arrive at our beachfront hotel for a 4-night stay. Enjoy a traditional New England experience as you indulge in a seafood feast. (BLD)
