Day # 1            Friday, September 26, 2025

Begin this picturesque journey by traveling via deluxe motorcoach across the Midwest and into Ohio for your overnight accommodations. Sit back, enjoy the ride and meet your new traveling companions. Dinner is included and the rest of your evening is at leisure. (D)

Day # 2            Saturday, September 27, 2025

After breakfast at the hotel, continue your travels toward New England, crossing a portion of Pennsylvania and New York, stopping this evening in Utica, NY for an overnight stay. After checking into your hotel, you are invited to join us for dinner at one of the local restaurants. (B,D)

Day # 3            Sunday, September 28, 2025

Breakfast is served at the hotel before re-boarding the motorcoach and traveling into Massachusetts. We arrive at the Red Lion Inn in Stockbridge for an included upscale colonial style luncheon at this historic Inn. A landmark in the Berkshires region of Western Massachusetts the Red Lion Inn began life as a small tavern with a red lion sign on the door back in 1773. After lunch we tour the Norman Rockwell Museum which houses the world's largest and most significant collection of original Rockwell art. Sit back and relax as we travel the country roads on our way to dinner this evening at the Salem Cross Inn. Experience the crackling fires in the fieldstone fireplaces and the glorious smells of delicious food being prepared especially for you. After dinner we check into the Comfort Inn Sturbridge for our overnight stay. (B,L,D)

Day # 4            Monday, September 29, 2025

After an included breakfast we head to Maine. Your first stop will be to enjoy free time shopping at the Stonewall Kitchen Store in York, manufacturers of Maine-made specialty condiments, jams and vinegars. Named for the graceful stonewalls that surround the original farm where the business began. Lunch is on your own at the onsite café. Next, we will stop at the southernmost lighthouse in Cape Neddick, Nubble Lighthouse. Our travels continue north for free time to enjoy the villages of Ogunquit and Perkins Cove. With great shops and fantastic photo opportunities with the lobster boats, sail boats and a unique drawbridge. Enjoy a welcome reception at your south coast Maine resort in Ogunquit. Settle into the comforts of Meadowmere Resort. The hotel is within walking distance of the Marginal Way shoreline path. This evening, we are treated to a down east Lobster dinner. You will feast on your choice of Maine boiled lobster or chicken including all the fixins. (B,D)

Day #5            Tuesday, September 30, 2025

Enjoy breakfast this morning before meeting your local guide for a narrated tour of Kennebunkport. Drive past the sandy beaches and rocky coastline, past the George Bush Estate at Walker's Point, hear the history of these shipbuilding towns and the legend of the Wedding Cake House. After your tour you board a lobster boat for a Maine lobstering cruise. Learn how the Maine lobstermen make their living as traps are hauled from the ocean along the rocky coast of Kennebunkport. See the sights as you cruise on the ocean past Walkers Point, Dark Shadows House and Bumpkin Island, home to a year-round colony of sea birds and seals. Next, we travel to North Woodstock, NH to relive the romance of dining on the rails aboard the Cafe Lafayette Dinner Train. Board a beautifully restored vintage Pullman railroad car and enjoy a leisurely two-hour evening ride among the lush New England Forest and magnificent mountain vistas accompanied by an elegant five course feast. We now make our way to the White Mountain Region of New Hampshire. We check into our hotel for a two-night stay. (B,D)

Day #6            Wednesday, October 1, 2025

A hearty continental breakfast is provided this morning in anticipation of our New Hampshire touring. This morning you will enjoy a round-trip cruise on the New Hampshire's largest lake on board a replica steamship, M/S Mount Washington. Lunch is included. Upon our return to the mainland, we will visit the Wright Museum of WWII History. The museum includes historically accurate exhibits that bring to life the American experience on the Homefront from 1939-1945. Free time to explore the Old Country Store and Museum in Moultonborough. This authentic country store and museum is one of the oldest surviving businesses in the United States. Dinner is included this evening before returning to our hotel. (B,L,D)

Day # 7            Thursday, October 2, 2025

After breakfast we travel to Cannon Mountain. Our day starts with panoramic views of the White Mountains. You will board the 80 person Cannon Mountain Aerial Tram to the summit. Have your camera for the panoramic views of the distant valleys and mountains where you can see four states on a clear day. Travel to Waterbury, Vermont for a visit to the Cold Hollow Cider Mill for a tour and sampling. Bakery, live beehive, fudge, world famous cider doughnuts & New England crafts available. Lunch is included. Next, we have free time in Church Street Marketplace in the heart of downtown Burlington, VT. Recognized as one of the "Great Places in America", this pedestrian-only section of town features 80 stores, including well-known chain shops and locally owned specialty stores. Dinner is included before we check into the historic Middlebury Inn for the night. Look out over the beautiful Middlebury town green from the front porch and experience a place that has been a part of Vermont's history since 1827. (B,LD)

Day # 8            Friday, October 3, 2025

There is breakfast to enjoy before you begin to travel south and then west. Our first stop this morning is the New England Maple Museum to see the largest collection of maple sugaring artifacts existence and

watch demonstrations on Vermont's sweetest commodity. You will journey through the process from sap to syrup and enjoy some sampling here. Afterwards shop their large selection of maple and Vermont products. Our next stop is Hildene, The Lincoln Family Home. Tour the Robert Todd Lincoln Home and enjoy the sweeping mountain views and beautiful estate and gardens along with a Pullman railroad car used by Teddy Roosevelt. A box lunch will be provided before our departure. We continue our travels west to our overnight stay in Rochester, NY. (B,L,D)

Day # 9            Saturday, October 4, 2025

Rise & Shine! Your deluxe motorcoach is ready and waiting. We continue our travels today with a stop at Niagara Falls State Park. Upon arrival we board the Maid of the Mist for a sightseeing tour of Niagara Falls, NY starting and ending on the American side. It is time to make our way to Ohio for our last overnight stay. Dinner is included this evening. (B,D)
